Week 17: Willing to Stick Together

Hebrews 10:23-24

- We are called to hold unswervingly to the hope of salvation and heaven.
 - *What are some of the things that try to get us to swerve away from this hope?*
 - *In your life specifically, what are ways that you can get discouraged?*
 - *What are things that attempt to distract you from God's mission and God's promises?*
- In our efforts to hold unswervingly, we are told to consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. We all need spurring on, we naturally slow down and push ourselves less, we naturally become selfish and self-focused rather than selfless and God focused. But we are to spur each other with careful consideration. The things that inspire and motivate one person may paralyze another.
 - *What kind of spurring do you best respond to?*
 - *What are the most effective ways for you to be pushed toward greater love and greater good deeds?*
 - *What are some ways of motivation that you don't respond well to?*
- The only way that we will deeply understand how to encourage and spur other brothers and sisters on, and how those same brothers and sisters will understand how to spur us on is if we are committed to constantly meeting together. It is only through sheer magnitude of time with people that we can learn them on this level.
 - *Why is it an easy habit to give up meeting with the body?*
 - *What are the meetings of the body that you struggle with desiring to be at?*
 - *How well do you know the people around you in the fellowship now?*
 - *Why would you want to deeply learn who other brothers and sisters are?*
- We all need encouragement, and when the body of Christ gathers together for any occasion, it should be a source of encouragement for all members of the body. When we meet together, love, peace, faith, and joy must exude and radiate from among us.
 - *What are your strengths when it comes to encouragement and spurring others on?*
 - *How can you better be a source of encouragement?*

Application: We must be willing to stick together through the good times and the bad times, we must be willing to deeply know how to encourage and challenge our brothers and sisters and be willing to allow them to deeply know how to encourage and challenge us.

This week, ask 1 member of the team how they feel best encouraged, ask them what best motivates them to push for God more.
